Odalan, a Balinese Hindu temple anniversary, is celebrated every 210 days following the Balinese Pawukon calendar. This special occasion marks the anniversary of our main Padmasana temple.

We invite you to be part of this sacred celebration, beginning at 3 PM at Jahe Restaurant with a traditional dance and water blessing ritual, culminating in a prayer at our Padmasana temple.

BHATARA TURUN KABEH

April 12 – May 3 Besakih Temple, Karangasem

Bhatara Turun Kabeh is a sacred festival held during Bali's 10th lunar month at Pura Besakih, the island's largest temple complex. This celebration brings together Balinese Hindu families to offer prayers and receive blessings, as it is believed that the deities descend to the temple during this time.

GALUNGAN April 23

Galungan is one of the key celebration in the Balinese pawukon calendar, symbolizing the triumph of good over evil. Families honor ancestral spirits with offerings and ceremonies, while streets and homes are adorned with penjor—beautiful bamboo poles with hanging decorations, adding a festive atmosphere across Bali.
